## **Therapist Job Description and Responsibilities**

A Physical Therapist (PT) provides a variety of medical services to help individuals who have been injured or physically affected by illness to recover or improve function. A Physical Therapist must be able to evaluate a patient's condition and devise a customized, individualized physical rehabilitation and treatment plan to enhance strength, flexibility, range of motion, motor control, and reduce any pain, discomfort and swelling the patient is experiencing. This includes the development, implementation and coordination of a physical therapy program. Supervision of a Physical Therapy Assistant (PTA) may also be required.

## **Physical Therapist Education and Training**

All qualified PT's must have completed an accredited physical therapy education program and passed the required licensure exam and have a license that is in good standing for the State of Arizona. Experience is preferred; **new graduates are encouraged to apply.**
